Conference Fundraisers

Regional Conferences

• Ms. Moore reported that \$3,000 was raised during the Flip-a-Coin fundraiser at the South Regional Conference.

Annual Conference

• Ms. Vercellone gave an overview of the Sunday night bowling fundraiser event. The revenue goal is \$14,000 (with an expected cost of \$8,000, including food and beverages.)

• There will be an Education Foundation Reception on Tuesday evening at the C3X conference from 5:15-6:30 pm. The board was asked for input.

Mr. Turner to seek sponsorship for the Education Foundation Reception.

NACAS Rebrand Update and Website Preview

- The new NACAS website home page is in the works and was shared with the board.
- Mr. Turner and Mekanic will ensure the location of the Education Foundation and donation links are easily accessible.
- The new website is on target to launch on June 1st.

NACAS Marketplace

- Mr. Salem introduced the NACAS Marketplace idea and how it would benefit members:
 - o Enhanced Buyer's Guide
 - 1FS Catalog [food service]
 - Resource Repository [best-in-class RFPs, job descriptions, resumes & a link to a Lounge community dedicated to more direct buyer and seller line of communication]
 - Procurement Portal [business development opportunity with potential business partners]
 Research Portal
- The NACAS Board of Directors was shown the Marketplace presentation and agreed to move forward and present this to the Education Foundation Board of Directors to request funding.
- Mr. Turner reviewed the scope and cost of this project and the proposed funding streams.
 Once the Marketplace is in place, the NACAS office will manage it internally and there are no planned ongoing expenses to operate it. This topic will be discussed further at the joint Finance Committee meeting in June.

NACAS Board of Directors Report

• Mr. Wahr reported that nominations are open for upcoming NACAS board and committee chair vacancies.

NACAS National Office Report

- Ms. Finn reported that attendance was high at the South Regional Conference with more institutional members present than business partners (351 people including approximately 185 institutional members.)
- C3X registration is open and as of last Wednesday, there were 70 people registered (52 ahead of this time last year.)
- Membership renewals are 41% higher compared to this same time last year (68 institutions renewed in April.)
- The regional business partner representatives met prior to the South conference to work together on creating the same sponsorship opportunities and business partner pricing structure for all regions. All regions plan to have the same categories by 2019.

- Stephanie Feuerstein is no longer employed with NACAS. This position will be filled in the coming weeks.
- Ms. Finn gave a review of the NACAS brand and Strategic Long-range plan. The big goal of NACAS will be revised and discussed at the NACAS Board of Directors meeting in July
- Ms. Finn reviewed the Future Campaign, the 2017 fundraising plan for the next eight months and next steps.
